Table of abbreviations for architectural elements like A.C.A., A.C.I., A.S.P., etc., with their corresponding full names.

GENERAL NOTES

- 1. The Contractor shall examine and become familiar with all contract documents in their entirety. Survey the project and become familiar with the existing conditions and scope of work. All costs submitted shall be based on thorough knowledge of all work and materials required. Any discrepancy and/or uncertainty as to what material or product is to be used should be verified with the Owner.

HEADERS @ OPENINGS @ TRUSS-LOADED BEARING WALLS table with columns for rough opening size, header size, and jack stud info.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

- 1. All stud walls are dimensioned 3 1/2" (actual) U.M.O.
- 2. The unit separation is dimensioned 6" (3 1/2" + 1" air space + 3 1/2") frame to frame unless otherwise noted.
